The Emergency Management Institute developed the Introduction to ICS for Schools (IS-100.SCa for Schools) course in collaboration with the U.S. Department of Education. The course is designed primarily for kindergarten through high school personnel. The overall course goal is to promote school safety by:

1. Familiarizing you with how ICS principles can be applied in school-based incidents.
2. Preparing you to interface with community response personnel

IS-100.SCa for Schools follows the National Incident Management System (NIMS) guidelines. Course Objectives

1. ICS applications in school-based incidents.
2. ICS organizational principles and elements.
3. ICS positions and responsibilities.
4. ICS facilities and functions.
5. ICS planning.
