



# MGT-313 INCIDENT MANAGEMENT / UNIFIED COMMAND

**April 28-30, 2009**

This course is the next step in HLS Region 5's (Pierce County's) efforts to provide a strong Incident Command System (ICS) training program. MGT-313 IM/UC trains emergency response supervisors and managers in the skills necessary to effectively plan for and manage large scale incidents, including those involving CBRNE/terrorism by applying the all-hazards command and management structures found the National Incident Management System (NIMS) – specifically ICS, Multi-Agency Coordination Systems, and Public Information Systems.

The course uses a multidiscipline “teambuilding” approach to accomplish the learning objectives. It consists of lectures, small group discussions and activities, multimedia scenarios, and a tabletop exercise based on our local jurisdictions. Upon course completion, participants will possess a working knowledge of local, state, and federal WMD incidents as well as other large-scale, multi-jurisdictional, multi-discipline incidents. This is a hands-on opportunity to go to the next level in your understanding of how Unified Command works effectively during large-scale incidents.
