On the **References** page

- include resources you have quoted or paraphrased.
- list resources in alphabetical order by author’s last name.
- indent entries that are more than one line in length.

Basic Format for Books - Author’s Lastname, Firstinitial. (year published). *Title of Book*. City: Publisher.

	Book - three or more authors	Strong, B., DeVault, C., & Sayad, B. W. (1999). <i>Human sexuality: Diversity in contemporary America</i> . Mountain View CA: Mayfield. <i>For more than 6 authors, use the first six followed by et al.</i>
	Book - corporate author	American Psychiatric Association. (2000). <i>Diagnostic and statistical manual of mental disorders:DSM-IV-TR</i> (4th ed.). Washington, DC: Author.
	Book - online	Baker, J. A., & Hamilton, L. H. (2006). <i>The Iraq study group report</i> . New York: Vintage Books. Retrieved August 8, 2007, from United States Institute of Peace Web site: http://www.usip.org/isg/iraq%5Fstudy%5Fgroup%5Freport/report/1206/iraq%5Fstudy%5Fgroup%5Freport.pdf .

Basic Format for Articles - Author's Lastname, Initials. (date). Title of article. Title of Journal, volume, page numbers. Retrieved Month dd, yyyy, from Name of database (document number if available).

Journal article - library database	Carmichael, M. (2006). The perils of plastic amnesia. <i>Ecologist</i> , 36(10), 30-32. Retrieved August 8, 2007, from Academic Search Premier database (AN 23131480). <i>Note: 36(10) indicates volume & issue. Always include the journal issue (if available) along with the volume number. Include the article number if End the citation with the document number (if applicable).</i>
Journal article - printed journal.	Maslin, M. (2004). Ecological versus climatic thresholds. <i>Science</i> , 306 (5705), 2197-2198.
Article - without an author - weekly magazine	Extending the Iraq timeline to 2009. (2007, August 3). <i>The Week</i> , 7(321), 2.
Magazine article - Internet	Pelusi, N. (2006, May/June). The right way to rock the boat. <i>Psychology Today</i> . Retrieved August 8, 2007, from http://www.psychologytoday.com/articles/index.php?term=pto-20060425-000001&page=1
Newspaper article - library database	Sando, M. (2006, August 19). Camp Cheney. <i>The News Tribune</i> , p. C3. Retrieved August 8, 2007, from ProQuest database (1102493971).
CQ Researcher	Clemmitt, M. (2007, June 1). Shock jocks. <i>CQ Researcher</i> , 17(21), 481-504. Retrieved August 8, 2007, from CQ Researcher Online.

Basic Format for Web Sites - Author's Lastname, Initials (or organization name). (Date page was created or updated). Title of web page. Retrieved date you used the source, from URL that links directly to the information.
