Mail-In or FAX Registration Instructions:

Registration by mail or FAX will be accepted and processed starting the first day of open/new student registration. Classes fill early—register soon! Last day to register using this form is one week prior to classes beginning. Please note the following guidelines:

- You may enroll for classes offered through the Puyallup and Fort Steilacoom campuses, or through Continuing Education.
- **You must enroll in 5 or fewer credits. If you are enrolling for 6 or more credits, you need an advisor's signature on your registration form and should fax the form ATTN: Advising Center.**
- **If you are enrolling for a course that requires a prerequisite, you must fax your transcript showing that you've met the prerequisite -- ATTN: Advising Center. Note: This only applies if you did not take the prerequisite course at Pierce College.**
- You **must** register in person for ABE, ESL, GED, and high school completion courses.
- You must take Pierce College's placement test prior to registering for Math OR English courses or courses that require Math or English as prerequisites.
- **FULL PAYMENT MUST ACCOMPANY THE REGISTRATION FORM.**
- To confirm you are registered, contact the Registration Office or obtain a copy of your schedule online at www.pierce.ctc.edu (Student Online Services).

Complete the registration form. Be sure to answer all questions on the form and check that all item numbers are correct. For each class, fill in any additional fee shown in the class listing (for instance, lab fees).

For classes offered by Fort Steilacoom and Puyallup, item numbers 1000-5999 and 7000-9998, refer to the tuition table and fee information to determine payment.

IMPORTANT: The tuition table DOES NOT include fees -- you MUST read the fee information provided to calculate your final tuition due. For Continuing Education classes, see class listing for fees. **Incorrect tuition payments will delay your registration.**

If you wish to charge your registration to your VISA or MasterCard, fill in ALL credit card information at the bottom of the Mail-In/FAX Registration Form.
