Courses are completed on a self-paced basis within the quarter; each five credit course requires 50 hours of attendance. At the individual student orientation, you will select specific days and times for lab attendance.

Registration requirements include high school transcript, COMPAS test scores, and a current telephone number where you can be reached. Mail transcripts to Pierce College, 9401 Farwest Drive SW, Lakewood, WA 98498, Attention: High School Completion.

- Approximate tuition and fees for resident HSC students 19 years or older is \$100 per class.
- Students under the age of 19 and non-resident students pay full tuition and fees of approximately \$400 per class. (See Tuition Table in this bulletin.)
- A High school release form may be required.
- A standard Washington high school diploma is issued upon completion of the requirements and official transcript on file.
- To enroll, instructor/advisor permission required. Call for an appointment.
