

Implanting a Memory

What is a cue that the memory may be false?

Repetitive – discussed, heard, told or thought about the story over and over again.

In vulnerable state

Therapist gives repeated exercises

Once you've started down deception path... exaggerated your answer, told a lie, wasn't honest to protect yourself

Confusion at beginning... maybe she remembers someone else, not me

Other important people remember it

Spend time imagining it

Don't talk to others who have info after false info introduced

What's not a cue?

The vividness or detail of the memory

One's confidence in the memory

What's the experience of it?

As real as other memories

With explanations

What is a cue that the memory may be false?

Repetitive – discussed, heard, told or thought about the story over and over again.

Each time you pull something from LTM, probably chunks from each part of LTM, and re-organize, you put new chunks along side/on top of old chunks, later that new chunk is recalled first

In vulnerable state

Looking for answers, STM run by questions and interpretations
Therapist gives repeated exercises

Combines 2 processes above

Once you've started down deception path... exaggerated your answer, told a lie, wasn't honest to protect yourself

You repeat, you build detail
