

## Real Life Examples of Schemas

### Studying

Remember it by what you were thinking - "things that don't make sense"

Or run everything together, no chunking, so less info

Conversations - don't hear what they said, heard what you were wondering about

Only remember details relevant to schema

Remember the idea, not the details. How you made meaning can be very different than what they intended.

Cross cultures, cross genders, etc. :

You hear the specifics, you don't hear the schema - what else it goes along with, how important it is, who should be involved

Whose his father? "He acts like he has no family"

Mistakes as overlapping / intertwined chunks
