# **Class Details Guide**

This guide will show you how to interpret the Class Details when you are searching for classes on the Class Schedule.

From here, you can get more detailed information about the class section. Let's go through each segment.

#### Information

The Information section shows general data about the class. Here are some key items:

- **Class Number**: This is the unique identifying number for this particular class.
- Session: Regular Academic Session or Dynamic Dated sessions have different start/end dates.
- Units: The number of units/credits the class is worth.
- **Description**: A detailed description of the class and what it is about.
- Enrollment Requirements: A description of the applicable prerequisites for the class.
- **Class Notes**: Additional notes about the class.

## Details: Asynchronous Online, Synchronous Online, Hybrid, or In Person

The Details fields are where you can tell if a course is Asynchronous online, Synchronous online, Hybrid, or In Person.

#### Asynchronous Online

This is an example of an **Asynchronous Online** class. This means you do not need to be "in-class" or on your computer at a specific time.

- The "Meets" field is **TBA** (no days or times listed).
- The "Room" field is either **Pierce College Online** or **JBLM Online**.
- The "Instruction Mode" is **Online**.

#### Synchronous Online

This is an example of a **Synchronous Online** class. This class is **online**, but requires students to be "inclass" during certain days and times. Students will "attend" class virtually during the times listed for the class.

- The "Meets" field has a **Meeting Pattern** that lists specific days and times that you will be required to be online.
- The "Instruction Mode" is **Online**.
- The "Room" field is either Pierce College Online or JBLM Online.

This is an example of a **Hybrid class with an In-Person component**. This class is hosted **online**, but also requires students to be **on-campus** during the listed days and times.

- The "Meets" field has a **Meeting Pattern** that lists specific days and times that you will be required to be on campus.
- The "Instruction Mode" is **Hybrid**.
- The "Room" field is going to list an **In-Person location on campus** (Campus, Building and Room Number).

#### In Person

This is an example of an **In Person** class. This class is fully in-person and requires students to be **oncampus** during the listed days and times.

- The "Meets" field has a **Meeting Pattern** that lists specific days and times that you will be required to be on campus.
- The "Instruction Mode" is **In Person**.
- The "Room" field is going to list an **In-Person location on campus** (Campus, Building and Room Number).

# Textbooks

# **Class Availability**

Finally, the Class Availability section shows if the class is open, and lists the number of seats that are still available.

- Status = Open or Closed
- Seats Open = The number of seats in the class that are available out of the total number of seats in the class
- Wait List Open = The number of waitlist seats that are available out of the total number of waitlist seats
