Scholarships Making a Difference for Pierce College Students

In 2024, the Pierce College Foundation awarded 211 scholarships for a total of \$102,183.

These scholarships have helped students overcome financial barriers and focus on their academic goals, contributing to higher retention and graduation rates.

Student Success Grants Lend a Helping Hand

Many Pierce College students encounter financial hardship off-campus, hindering their ability to progress towards their academic goals.

In order to address this barrier, the Pierce College Foundation provides access to Student Success Grants, which assist students struggling to pay for basic needs such as housing costs, living expenses, medical bills, transportation, and childcare.

In 2024, the Pierce College Foundation awarded **39** Student Success Grants totaling **\$42,069** in emergency grants.

To qualify students must:

- Be enrolled in 6 credits
- Have completed at least one term at Pierce College
- Earned a 2.0 or higher GPA
- Have no previous term debt
- Submitted a FAFSA or WASFA application
